OPTION 1 FACE-TO-FACE ON CAMPUS LEARNING (K5-12)

- Before student comes to school, parent will check their child's temperature if they have a fever over 100.4, or a cough, shortness of breath, loss of smell or taste or have been in direct contact with someone who has COVID-19 they must stay home and contact a medical provider.
- Temperature checks will be conducted prior to entering the facility.
- Upon arrival all students must wear a face covering, pick up breakfast and proceed to to homeroom class.
- All students should bring a water bottle to school, all water fountains will be closed for regular use; water fountain may only be used to refill water bottles throughout the day.
- When students are moving around the classroom, they must wear a face covering.
- When in the classroom, students may remove their face covering when working independently at their desk.
- Students will be required to have their own materials (pencils, pens, crayons, etc.). Sharing between classmates will not be allowed.
- Students must bring their own sanitizer and/or sanitizing wipes to sanitize their own area throughout the day.
- Desks and tables will be spaced apart and will all face one direction.
- Elementary students will eat lunch in their classroom (each class will have a scheduled day to sit in the gathering).
- Middle/High school students will eat in the gathering and must wear a face covering while waiting in line. Seating in the gathering will be marked and spaced a part.
- When changing classes or going to an enrichment elective, students will wear their masks, and practice social distancing. Students will be required to follow one-directional signs in hallways.
- Students in music, band, choir, and performing arts must wear a face covering when singing.
- Access to classrooms will be limited to students and staff members only.
- PCCA will have a designated isolation area in the event that a child or a staff member comes to school and presents COVID-19 symptoms.

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OPTION 2 E-LEARNING (LIVE SESSIONS) (K5-12)

- Students must have their own tablet, laptop or computer with a camera and microphone. If you have multiple students at home doing e-learning, each child must have their own device.
- If you do not have a device, you may lease one from PCCA at a cost of \$400 (monthly payments of \$40). Once the lease payments have been fulfilled the device will become property of the student. PCCA is not responsible for repairs or screen replacements in case of damage. *Please see Mrs. Clark (Accounts Manager) for further information.*
- Students will be expected to participate in “LIVE SESSIONS” throughout the day.
- A schedule will be provided, and your child must be logged on at a specific time. Example: If you have math at 10:00am, your child is required to be logged in to their math class for the entire period.
- Student doing e-learning will see the teacher while he/she is providing instructions and allowed to raise their hands and ask questions if they need to.
- Students must wear their uniform throughout their scheduled learning.
- Small breaks throughout the day will be provided.
- Students must maintain a “C” or 2.0 average to continue e-learning.
- All students will be tested with the NWEA testing during e-learning. We are required to document tests results and submit them to the Florida Department of Education to track learning gaps.
- Students must be in regular attendance and failure to do so may result in dismissal from e-learning option.
- E-learning may be a recovery tool for students who become ill or who need to quarantine during the school year.
- If e-learning is your choice of education for this upcoming school year, your child must remain in the program unless a life changing event occurs. Changes to your educational plan will only be approved by administration.
- Our food program is available for students doing e-learning. Parents are welcome to pick up curbside on Mondays and Wednesdays for the entire week.

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OPTION 3 Hybrid (K5-12)

- On campus days- Tuesdays and Thursdays
- E-learning days- Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays
- Must abide by e-learning and on campus learning rules and regulations as listed above.
- If hybrid is your choice of education for this upcoming school year, your child must remain in the program unless a life changing event occurs. Changes to your educational plan will only be approved by administration.
- Our food program is available for students doing hybrid. Parents are welcome to pick up curbside on Mondays and Wednesdays for the entire week.



As of now educational options are available for first semester ONLY unless otherwise approved by Florida Department of Education.
